Applicants must demonstrate outstanding performance in their studies and are expected to obtain a Masters' degree in one of the following fields

- Elementary Particle Physics
- Hadron and Nuclear Physics
- Atomic Physics and Physics with Ultra-Cold Neutrons
- Nuclear Chemistry
- Astroparticle Physics
- Theoretical Particle, Hadron and Nuclear Physics
