Applicants must demonstrate outstanding performance in their studies and are expected to have obtained a Masters' degree in one of the following fields:

- Experimental Hadron and Nuclear Physics
- Atomic Physics, Precision Observables and Physics with Ultra-Cold Neutrons
- Nuclear Chemistry
- Experimental Particle and Astroparticle Physics
- Theoretical Particle, Hadron and Nuclear Physics
